ROLL CALL: The following answered to roll call - Chair Bob Anderson and Trustees Patti Coughlin and Eric Anderson attended via online resources. Also present: Village Administrator Amy K. Huber, Village Clerk Daisha Nolan and Public Works Lead Nick Hofstader. Committee member Jim Jonasen was absent.

REVIEW OF AGENDA: No Agenda Changes.

MINUTES: A motion was made by Coughlin to approve the regular session minutes from October 28, 2020, as presented, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

PUBLIC INPUT: Input from Nancy Paulson was shared via writing from Swan Dawson regarding icy conditions in front of the Auditorium during school lunch pick up and on Degerman Road following the snow received on October 15th. Swan Dawson shared the suggestion of communicating when plows are out.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Eagle Scout Project:** Jack Huber presented that he would like to have consideration for a dog park located at Cleary Park for his Eagle Scout project. This will be added to January's agenda for further discussion and consideration.
2. **Operator's Report:** Nick Hofstader presented the Public Works report. There will be an ordinance review for the consideration of garbage cans which are creating obstacles during the plow season.
3. **East Lake Boulevard Repair** - This will be removed from the agenda and revisited in the Spring of 2021.
4. **Cleveland Road Damage and Maple Creek Ditching** - This will also be revisited in the Spring due to early winter weather.
5. **5 Year Road Plan** - Revisions were made to the plan at the last Board Meeting.
6. **Winter Lake Access** - Public Works employee Nick Hofstader will begin grooming the area located by Dairy Queen to serve as winter access to the lake to prevent any damage to the newly constructed Boat Landing.
7. **Stormwater Damage on Waterfront Drive** - Biofreeze will be purchased and this will be reassessed in the Spring
8. **Snow Plowing** - A meeting with plow drivers and the public works committee will be scheduled to discuss future snow plowing and assess changes needed after the first snowfall.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. **Blue Jay Drive** - B. Anderson will address the correspondence requesting plowing on Blue Jay Drive, which is a private driveway.
2. **Phillips Road** - This will be revisited in the Spring for repairs.
