- William Urbaniak still owns the Lawn Beach Inn, and his potential buyer intends to open it back up as a restaurant and will still require the license.
- The process of renewing a liquor license is exponentially easier than re-obtaining the license after it has lapsed.
- The current license for the Lawn Beach Inn will expire on June 30, 2021.

Motion by B. Anderson to approve the issuance of a Class B liquor retailer's license to William Urbaniak for the Lawn Beach Inn, seconded by Fuller. MCU
