

**Village of Lake Nebagamon, Douglas County, Wisconsin  
Amendment to the Municipal Code**

**Chapter 12 ORDERLY CONDUCT, Section 12.02(c)(3)(i) of the Municipal Code of the Village of Lake Nebagamon entitled “Radios, Televisions, Boom Boxes, Phonographs, Stereos, Musical Instruments and Similar Devices” is hereby amended to provide as follows:**

**(Noises Prohibited)**

**i. Radios, Televisions, Boom Boxes, Phonographs, Stereos, Musical Instruments and Similar Devices.** Operating, playing or permitting the operation or playing of any radio, television, phonograph, drum, musical instrument, sound amplifier, or similar device which produces, reproduces or amplifies sound in such a manner as to create a noise disturbance, or which unreasonably disturbs the peace, quiet and comfort of neighbors and passers-by, or be plainly audible across a real property boundary in a residential zone, or plainly audible at a distance of 50 feet from any person in a commercial, industrial area, or public space is prohibited:


In zoning districts C-1 and C-2:


- a. Between the hours of 12:00 am (midnight) and 7:00 am the following day on Friday and Saturday nights, as well as designated holidays and
- b. Between the hours of 11:00pm to 7:00am Sunday night through Thursday nights.

In all other types of zoning districts, the prohibition set out above shall apply between the hours of 11:00pm and 7:00am the following day, every night of the week.

**This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and publication.**
